

## April 4, 2022 Historical Advisory Committee Meeting

Members of the Historical Committee met at 7:00 p.m. in the History Center. Members had to enter in the back side door of the Center, due to the fact the foyer area was blocked off due to renovations. The Library is expanding into the foyer area and no one can enter that area. They received a grant to cover the renovations. They have the windows from the Center into the foyer completely covered. Patrons of the Library have to enter into the emergency exit doorway and those entering the Great Room must enter into the end door. Library patrons that want to use the restroom facilities must go outside and down to the entrance being utilized for the Great Room. They expect the renovations to take about 4 months.

The contents from the large display case that was in the foyer has been moved into the History Center; leaving somewhat of a mess. The large display case has been moved into the Great Room Area. The display case was originally built with Recreation funds to house the numerous trophies and placed in the meeting/court room at Town Hall. It was moved to the foyer area of the Community Center and shared with the Historical Committee. Once we can open our entrance door, these items will need to be moved. Between the Covid pandemic and the renovations, it has made it difficult to get things done at the Center.

The Library will be having their book sale in the Great Room on Saturday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p. Everyone must enter from the far right side door into the Great Room. Plans to have the History Center open that day have been canceled due to the renovations and no public access to the History Center.

Discussion was held on the South Jersey History Fair to be held on June 11<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The next meeting we will select items to take to the event.

Kathryn stated that she was registering the organization she has started for basket weaving and cooking for a separate booth. She said she would request to be next to our Historical Committee's booth. Diane, Monica and Carol plan to attend along with Carolyn Gant.

The release of the 1950 Census information was discussed. People can now research those records on line.

The May meeting final plans will be made for the South Jersey History Fair.
