RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
BONUS GRANT FOR FOOD WASTE, ABANDONED TIRES
AND PUBLIC SPACE RECYCLING

WHEREAS. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has announced a \$400,000 "Bonus" grant program that will provide targeted grants for recycling initiatives in three areas: food waste recycling, scrap tire removal and recycling in public spaces. Bonus grants will be made available to local governments (municipalities and counties) and to county institutions (colleges, health care and corrections facilities). This program is funded through the Recycling Tax established in the "Recycling Enhancement Act".

WHEREAS. The recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

WHEREAS. A resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the Bonus Grant for Food Waste, Abandoned Tires and Public Space Recycling will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of (Township of Franklin) to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Franklin of Township of Franklin that Township of Franklin hereby endorses the submission of the Bonus Grant for Food Waste, Abandoned Tires and Public Space Recycling grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the Bonus Grant for Food Waste, Abandoned Tires and Public Space Recycling grant be used solely for the purposes outlined in the bonus Grant application.
