

RESOLUTION 153-15

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) TRAILER MOUNTED VACUUM LEAF COLLECTORS THROUGH THE NATIONAL JOINT POWERS ALLIANCE, A NATIONAL MUNICIPAL CONTRACTING AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin wishes to purchase two (2) ODB Trailer Mounted Vacuum Debris Collectors from an authorized vendor under the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA), a national municipal contracting agency; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin is permitted to join national cooperative purchasing agreements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)(3); and

WHEREAS, the NJPA has been awarded Contract No. 060612 for Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Equipment with Related Equipment, Accessories and Supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends the utilization of this contract on the grounds that it represents the best price available for the leaf collectors; and

WHEREAS, the actual cost of the purchase of SCL800TM25 is not expected to exceed \$41,438.00 per item; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that Old Dominion Brush Co., Inc., 5118 Glen Alden Drive, Richmond, VA 23231 shall be awarded the contract pending the completion of legal advertising requirements. Said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$82,876.00 to supply TWO -Model #SCL800TM25 ODB Trailer Mounted Vacuum Debris Collectors for the Township of Franklin; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the availability of a sufficient appropriation to fund the purchase authorized in this Resolution is an express and mandatory condition of the award of the contract; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Administrator is hereby authorized to sign the contract documents necessary to effectuate the award of the contract as set forth herein.
