RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A “NO PASSING ZONE”
ON ROUTE 40 IN FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) recently completed a traffic investigation on Route 40 in Franklin Township; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT recommends a revision to the centerline pavement markings on Route 40 to create a “No Passing Zone” in the vicinity of M.P. 26.10 (Oak Avenue), M.P. 27.63 (Morris Avenue), and M.P. 27.99 (Grubb Road) for safety reasons; and

WHEREAS, the project will create safer driving conditions in this area of Route 40; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that it supports the use of a “No Passing Zone” on Route 40 in Franklin Township as recommended by NJDOT.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to NJDOT as requested.
