

**RESOLUTION
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN**

TO CANCEL PROPERTY TAXES FOR A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN

WHEREAS, James Baldwin has submitted an application for and has been determined to receive a property tax exemption on a dwelling house of a disabled veteran, ; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Baldwin resides at a property known as 4085 Hancock Avenue, Williamstown (Franklin Township) which is also known as Block 601, Lot 6 on the official tax map of the Township of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Baldwin received said approval by way of letter from the Department of Veteran Affairs dated January 27, 2014;

WHEREAS, the Township Tax Collector, Larry Nightlinger, has recommended to the Township Committee that the exemption be granted based upon a 100% permanent and total disability having been determined and that the cancellation of taxes is therefore permitted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, et seq.;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That taxes for the above set forth property are hereby cancelled as of the February 2014 quarter in the amount of \$1,287.47 and that said amount should be refunded to the property owner.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, that all future taxes for the calendar year 2014 are hereby cancelled.
