

**RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF A TEMPORARY
TRAILER PERMIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ORDINANCES OF
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, Marcella Collins, as the owner of 224 Sunnyhill Avenue, Franklin Township, New Jersey, suffered mold in her home due to a leak in the basement; and

WHEREAS, as a result of a requirement of the insurance company and other factors, said property owner applied to the Township of Franklin for a temporary trailer to be utilized as a residence during the remediation of mold for said structure; and

WHEREAS, Franklin Township ordinance provides a finite term for the provision of a temporary trailer subject to the discretion of the governing body in extending same for extraordinary circumstances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the temporary trailer permit be issued in favor of Marcella Collins as the owner of 224 Sunnyhill Avenue for a period of three months from the date the trailer is put on said property. All permits must be applied for through the Zoning Office.
