AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY CANCELLING CERTAIN FUNDED CAPITAL APPROPRIATION BALANCES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$450,061.34 AND RE-APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL CAPITAL PROJECTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, in the County of Gloucester, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In accordance with N.J.S. 40A:2-39, the following appropriations, consisting of remaining balances as set forth below of various bond ordinances heretofore adopted by the Township and no longer needed for their identified purposes, are hereby cancelled:

Section 2. Having determined that it is in the best interests of the Township, the aggregate sum of \$450,061.34 is hereby re-appropriated from the bond ordinances set forth above and shall be used to undertake the capital projects set forth below:

C	Acquisition of equipment for Township Police Department, including from among the following: acquisition and installation of patrol vehicle video systems and related headquarters equipment, shot guns with related vehicle mounts and accessories, radar units with related accessories and one (1) automatic license plate reader.	\$153,030.00

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Township Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
