RESOLUTION REJECTING THE BID OF WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR TRASH
AND RECYCLING

WHEREAS, the Township Committee went out to bid to determine whether or not it would be effective to privatize waste collection in Franklin Township which is presently conducted by municipal employees within the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, a bid was received from Waste Management; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has reviewed said bid; and

WHEREAS, while the price for the collection of trash and recyclable materials is attractive, accepting said bid would result in the reduction in force of the Franklin Township Public Works Department which would make the Township unable to efficiently and effectively plow snow and handle other municipal projects such as road repairs, park clean up and the like;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the bid submitted by Waste Management and all other bids submitted by any and all other bidders be and are hereby rejected.
