RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF ONE RETIRED POLICE
VEHICLE TO THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN BUREAU OF FIRE
PREVENTION

WHEREAS, the Township has received correspondence dated October 10, 2012 from the Fire Marshall of Franklin Township requesting that a vehicle be transferred from the possession of the Police Department to the office of the Fire Marshall within Franklin Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin is presently retiring one police vehicle which would be suitable for use by the Fire Marshall; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes that it is in the best interest that a vehicle which while no longer acceptable for police use remain serviceable and effective for the office of the Bureau of Fire Prevention.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the Township of Franklin Police Department be and is hereby authorized to transfer one retiring police vehicle to the Bureau of Fire Prevention under the supervision of the Township Fire Marshall and to take all steps necessary to effectuate same.
