

**RESOLUTION
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
RESOLUTION EXTENDING TIME PERIOD TO CONSTRUCT A LIQUOR
STORE BUILDING IN FAVOR OF SAMUEL AYDEN
R-189-12**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has received a written request from Samuel Ayden who previously purchased a plenary liquor license from the Township of Franklin subject to certain conditions including that the proposed liquor store facility be constructed and open within a set period of time; and

WHEREAS, that period of time as established by virtue of the resolution authorizing the sale of the liquor license is about to expire; and

WHEREAS, Samuel Ayden, together with his engineer, appeared at the time of the public hearing on October 23, 2012 and stated on the record the reasons associated with the delay in opening the building including, but not limited to, delays associated with approvals required by outside agencies including the New Jersey Department of Transportation with regard to curb cuts and widening at that location along State Highway Route 40 where the business is to be opened; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee is aware of the significant and prolonged economic downturn which has confronted not only the State of New Jersey but the nation and which has prompted the New Jersey Legislature to enact the New Jersey Permit Extension Act which has subsequently been amended and extended by act of the Legislature and the Governor's office; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes it would be in the best interest of the residents of the Township of Franklin and in the best interest of Samuel Ayden to extend the period within which he is able to construct his building for a period of one year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the condition associated with the issuance of a liquor license to Samuel Ayden be and is hereby extended for a period of one year in order to allow the construction of a building.
