

**RESOLUTION
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITOR TO MAKE A
COUNTEROFFER TO A TAXPAYER SEEKING TO SETTLE A FORECLOSURE
R-190-12**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has received through the tax office an inquiry from a taxpayer whose property is currently in *In Rem Tax Foreclosure* seeking to establish an installment payment plan; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has reviewed said plan and has noted certain deficiencies wherein the plan proffered by the taxpayer does not comply with the parameters of the statute authorizing installment payments; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes it is in the best interest of the Township to obtain voluntary payment by taxpayers rather than resort to *In Rem Tax Foreclosure* in order to keep taxpaying properties on the tax rolls and for other good public policy reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the Township Solicitor be and is hereby authorized to make a counter proposal to the taxpayer which complies in all respects with the statute in order to attempt to resolve the *In Rem Tax Foreclosure*.
