

**ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
ORDINANCE CORRECTING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE O-17-11
VACATING A PORTION OF WEST SECOND STREET
O-13-12**

WHEREAS, the Township previously adopted Ordinance O-17-11; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Ordinance, vacated all title which the Township had in West Second Street between Harding Highway and Oak Avenue; and

WHEREAS, upon review of said Ordinance, it appears that the portion of West Second Street to have been vacated was misstated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. That all right, title and interest in the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester in West Second Street between Block 4804, Lots 4 and 5 and Block 4805, Lot 1 be and is hereby vacated. The vacated roadways are depicted on the tax maps of Franklin Township.

Section 2. All rights and privileges possessed, if any, at the time of this Ordinance by public utilities as defined in N.J.S.A. 48:2-13 shall be expressly reserved and excepted from vacation so that the said utilities may maintain, repair and replace their existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the street, highway, lane, alley, square, place or park or any part thereof to be vacated.

Section 3. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby replaced.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Jersey and filing with the County Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-21.
