WHEREAS, there exists a need for an Officer in Charge of the Township of Franklin Police Department, based upon the recent retirement of Cleo Howe; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That MICHAEL ROCK, is hereby appointed as Officer in Charge for the Township of Franklin Police Department.

2. The appropriate officers of the Township of Franklin are hereby authorized to enter into the attached contract with MICHAEL ROCK for the position above specified.

**AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES AS OFFICER-IN-CHARGE BETWEEN THE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN AND MICHAEL ROCK**

This Agreement is made on this 13th day of September, 2011, between the Township of Franklin (herein after referred to as the “Township” or “Employer”) and Michael Rock (herein after referred to as “Employee”).

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to secure the services of Employee as Officer-in-Charge (hereinafter “OIC”) of the Township of Franklin Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Township desires to formalize this Agreement and set forth the additional job duties and requirements of OIC; and,

WHEREAS, the Township and Employee enter into this Agreement upon terms which are as follows:

1. The OIC will be charged with certain management functions, duties and responsibilities including the responsibility to enforce the Rules and Regulations of the Police Department, including the taking of any disciplinary action with just cause, and to engage in other actions that are specifically provided to in this Agreement:
 - (a) Administer and enforce Rules and Regulations and special emergent directives for the disposition and discipline of the Police Force and its officers and personnel;
 - (b) Have, exercise and discharge the power, functions and duties of the Police Force;
 - (c) Describe the duties and assignments of all subordinates and other personnel;
 - (d) Delegate such authority as Employee shall deem necessary for the efficient operation of the Police Force to be exercised under his direction and supervision;
 - (e) Report monthly to the Township Committee in such form as shall be prescribed by Township Committee on the operation of the Police Force during the proceeding month.

These job duties and responsibilities are in addition to those existing police duties that Employee shall continue to perform.

2. Other Terms and Conditions. All other terms and conditions of Employee’s employment with the Township shall be governed by the Township of Franklin Police PBA Collective Bargaining Agreement currently in effect.
