

**TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
TRANSFERRING UNEXPENDED CAPITAL MONEY FROM PRIOR
COMPLETED CAPITAL PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, after review by its Auditor and Chief Financial Officer, has realized in its latest financial reports, the unexpended capital balances from previous Township Capital Improvement Bonding Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee desires to transfer those unexpended capital monies for use on other capital projects.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, New Jersey that the following unexpended capital monies be transferred from the following Capital Improvement Bond Ordinances:

O-16-02 Purchase Ambulance Equipment	100,000.00
O-24-02 Purchase Motorcycle Equipment	324.56
O-15-04 Purchase Playground Equipment	2,612.00
O-10-05 Parks & Recreation Improvements	5,764.56
O-7-06 Purchase DPW Equipment	40,000.00
Purchase Police Equipment	50,799.22
Purchase Office Equipment	499.66
TOTAL	200,000.00

And reappropriate those capital funds for the following categories:

Road Reconstruction and Resurfacing	200,000.00
TOTAL	200,000.00

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Township Treasurer of the Township of Franklin is hereby authorized to make the appropriate budget transfers in accordance with the above; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage adoption and publication as provided by Law.
