

**ORDINANCE

**ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 24 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF FRANKLIN, ENTITLED "CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER," AS
FOLLOWS:**

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin had established Chapter 24 of the Township Code, creating the position of the Code Enforcement Officer and enumerating the duties of the Code Enforcement Officer therein; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin has determined that the position of Code Enforcement Officer is unnecessary as the duties of the Code Enforcement Officer can be performed by the Planning and Zoning Administrative Officer; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township of Franklin, Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 24 of the Township Code is hereby rescinded and repealed.
