

**ORDINANCE  
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN  
O-12-2010**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 295, §8 CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
FRANKLIN, AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Franklin believes it is in the best interest of the public that costs associated with property clean up be recouped by the Township of Franklin in an amount that is sufficient to satisfy the Township for the actual costs associated with property maintenance performed by the Township and/or vendors employed by public agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 295 was last amended and up-dated in 1996; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs of performing certain activities have increased since that time; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township of Franklin, Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 295 - §8B shall be repealed and replaced with the following language:

B. The following costs to be charged and collected against said lands and premises for non-compliance with this Chapter shall be as follows:

(1) The actual costs paid for by or on behalf of the Township of Franklin for the clean up of said property; or

(2) In the event that the Township of Franklin Public Work Employees perform any property maintenance an amount equal to \$500.00 minimum charge plus \$500.00 per ton thereafter and \$100.00 per hour per employee plus \$100.00 per hour per piece of equipment for the time spent performing said property maintenance.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, adoption and publication as provided by law.
