

ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
O-7-08

AUTHORIZING A SALE OF TOWNSHIP OWNED PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin is the owner of certain undersized lands identified as Block 5317 Lot 7 and Block 2201 Lots 51 and 52 on the Tax Assessment Map of Franklin Township; and

WHEREAS, said properties are not needed for public use by the Township of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee is desirous of selling said properties at private sale to contiguous property owners, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b), subject to the land being sold as a single parcel, and subject to the highest bid and subject to a minimum bid of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for Block 5317 Lot 7 and three thousand one hundred dollars (\$3,100.00) for Block 2201 Lot 51 and three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for Block 2201 Lot 52 and any conditions as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the properties are sold "as is, where is" and the Township does not make any representations as to the properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that Block 5317 Lot 7; Block 2201 lots 51 and 52 owned by the Township are not needed for public use, shall be sold to a contiguous landowner by sealed bid; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all bids must be received by the Township Clerk's Office prior to 1:00 P.M. on Friday, _____, 2008 at which time all bids will be opened; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that each bidder is required to submit a deposit at the time of the bid of 10% of their bid, by cash or check; money order, or cashier's check; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, the balance of the purchase price for the above properties shall be paid to the Township Clerk by cash or certified check; money order, or cashier's check on or before 12:00 noon on _____, 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, in the event the successful bidders fail to pay the balance of the purchase price within the time specified, the Township Committee reserves the right to cancel the sale and retain the deposit as liquidated damages and sell the properties to the next highest bidder under the same terms and conditions; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the proper officials of the Township Committee are authorized to execute documents to complete such sale; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, the Township Committee reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
