**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY
CONDITION REGARDING TRASH COLLECTION AND AUTHORIZATION TO
OBTAIN CONTRACTS WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING
THE APPROPRIATE TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS TO TAKE APPROPRIATE
ACTION, INCLUDING THE ACQUISITION OF REPLACEMENT TRASH
TRUCKS AND VEHICLES PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.J.S.A
40A:11-6**

WHEREAS, an emergency condition has developed in the Township of Franklin where multiple trash trucks which are beyond their useful life have fallen into such a state of disrepair that the ability of the Township to provide trash collection services to its residents is in jeopardy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, the Township is permitted to award contracts without public bidding or quotes and to take other actions when an emergency affecting the health, welfare and safety of the public requires the immediate performance of services or acquisition of goods; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works responsible for trash collection in the Township has advised the Mayor and Township Committee that an emergent condition does in fact exist with respect to trash collection services in the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey that authorization be and is hereby given to the Township Administrator and other Township Officials to proceed with obtaining contracts and to take other appropriate action for trash collection services, including the acquisition of trash collection trucks, vehicles and equipment without public bidding pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and take all other action necessary to protect the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Township of Franklin with regard to this emergent condition; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
