

**ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
AMENDING ORDINANCE O-19-08
O-21-08**

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2008, the Township Committee voted to adopt Ordinance O-19-08 which vacated a portion of Hawthorne Avenue;

WHEREAS, the portion of Hawthorne Avenue to be vacated was incorrectly identified as that portion of Hawthorne Avenue lying between 1st Avenue and Route 40;

WHEREAS, the correct portion of Hawthorne Avenue to be vacated is lying between a section of Route 40 and Normandy Street; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee now wishes to amend O-19-08 to replace all mention of 1st Avenue with Normandy Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that Ordinance O-19-08 shall be amended to reflect that Hawthorne Avenue is to vacated between Normandy Street and Route 40.
