

**ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
AUTHORIZING THE REDUCTION OF
SPEED LIMIT ON WASHINGTON AVENUE IN FRANKLINVILLE**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, along with the Franklin Township Police Department, is desirous of ensuring that the residents of the Township of Franklin are protected on the roads of Franklin Township to the utmost degree allowed by statute; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin is desirous of acting upon a statutory prerogative allowing municipalities to provide for a thirty-five (35) mile per hour speed limit in any suburban business or residential district as outlined in N.J.S.A. 39: 4-98 (b)(2); and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and discussion with the Township Administrator, Engineer, and Solicitor, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester has determined that it is appropriate to reduce the speed on the entire length of Washington Avenue, from County Route 655 to Grant Avenue, to thirty-five (35) miles per hour; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, based on the recommendation made by the Franklin Township Police Department, that the reduction in speed on Washington Avenue in Franklinville to thirty-five (35) miles per hour, be and hereby is authorized in both directions for the entire length of roadway under the jurisdiction of the Township of Franklin;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a copy of this Ordinance be forwarded to the State of New Jersey, Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to such inconsistencies; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all ordinances or parts of ordinances not inconsistent with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect; and

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage by Committee or twenty (20) days after approval by the Mayor, whichever comes first.
