

**ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
AMENDING CHAPTER 185, CHECKS, RETURNED
O-10-07**

WHEREAS, Township Committee of the Township of Franklin wishes to amend Chapter 185, Checks, Returned, section 4, regarding future payments by cash or certified check after a party presents a check and it is returned for insufficient funds; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:5-18, states a municipality may require future payments to be tendered in cash, certified or cashier's check if a party's check is returned for insufficient funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, it hereby amends Chapter 185-4, as follows:

Section 4. Any future payments made on behalf of the party having previously issued payment returned for insufficient funds may be tendered in cash or by certified or cashier's check at the discretion of the municipal official; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Jersey.
