

**TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS
FROM OPEN SPACE & RECREATION FUND**

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, through the approval of the Planning Board is the recipient of funds from the Open Space & Recreation Fund in the amount of \$150,000.00 for the installation of lighting at the football complex; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin wishes to utilize these funds for the upgrade of lighting at the football complex on Pennsylvania Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the Township Committee to grant authority through its Chief Financial Officer to expend the funds noted herein for the purpose so designated; now

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, acknowledge the receipt of these funds from the Planning Board through the Open Space & Recreation Fund.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Township's Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to expend the funds in the amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 towards the installation of lighting at the football complex on Pennsylvania Avenue; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any section, sentence, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holdings shall not effect or impair any other section, sentence, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, adoption and publication provided by law.
