**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES AND WAGES
OF MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester in the State of New Jersey that the following salary and wage ranges are hereby established for municipal officials and employees of the Township of Franklin.

SECTION I. The salary and wages enumerated in this section shall be paid every other week at a sum equal to the annual salary divided by the number of pay periods in the calendar year or per hourly wages for hourly employees retroactive to January 1, 2007.

SECTION II. The salary and wages enumerated in this section shall be payable quarterly:

SECTION III. The salary and wages enumerated in this section shall be paid every month at a sum equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual salary or per hourly wages.

SECTION IV. The salary and wage ranges set forth in this ordinance shall be retroactive to January 1, 2007. Fringe benefits will be in accordance with respective collective bargaining agreements and individual employment agreements. State minimum wages are in effect per law.

SECTION V. The mileage reimbursement for business use of an employee's personal vehicles will be in accordance with the Internal Revenue Service Code, Section 162, Mileage Reimbursement Allowance Rate.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in the manner required by law.
