Finding No. 2017-001

Condition: The Township did not maintain a fixed asset accounting system in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.6.

Effect: Non-compliance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.6.

Cause: management oversight

Recommendation: That the internal control policies and procedures should be developed to properly maintain the general fixed assets accounting system in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.6.

View of Responsible Officials and Planned Corrective Action: The responsible officials agree with the finding.

Corrective Action Plan: Township officials will prepare inventory of fixed assets and develop procedures to account for fixed assets as purchased and disposed of in the future.
