

**RESOLUTION
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
RESOLUTION RE-ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF THE DIRECTOR OF
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020
R-169-19**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, abolished the position of Director of Community Development effective December 31, 2010 by Resolution R-151-10, and the Township Administrator took all steps necessary in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, wishes to employ a Director of Community Development, charged with among other things, running the Planning and Zoning Board Offices and other functions related to the development and betterment of the Township of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, will assign further duties and responsibilities to the Director of Community Development as best suits the needs of Franklin Township, and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes it would be in the best interest of the residents of Franklin Township to re-establish the position of Director of Community Development effective January 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the position of Director of Community Development be and is hereby re-established effective January 1, 2020, and the Township Clerk and Township Administrator shall take all steps necessary in connection therewith.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all prior Resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.
