RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IN THE MATTER OF COLEMAN VS. FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP, et al., DOCKET NO. GLO-L-000254-20

WHEREAS, a Civil action lawsuit was filed against the Township of Franklin alleging damages for claims including, but not limited to, claims for pain and suffering, embarrassment and humiliation, as well as emotional distress, and in consideration for the terms and conditions set forth in the Pleadings; and

WHEREAS, this particular action is entitled Coleman v. Franklin Township, et al., Gloucester County, Docket No.: GLO-L-000254-20; and

WHEREAS, John Armano, Esq. of the law firm, Trimble and Armano, P.A. was appointed to represent the Township of Franklin in the aforementioned litigation; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin after consultation with Mr. Armano believes it is in the best interest of the Township to resolve all claims without the need for further litigation and costs; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of same, the Township of Franklin shall enter into a Settlement Agreement for the consideration of the promises, covenants and releases set forth in the attached Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Settlement Agreement between the Township of Franklin and Katie Coleman subject to final review and approval by the Township Attorney.
