**PROHIBITING PART-TIME ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICIALS
AND PROFESSIONALS FROM RECEIVING
TAX PAYER FUNDED HEALTH BENEFITS AND PENSIONS**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, recognizes the fact that over many years certain municipalities and public entities have permitted part-time elected and appointed officials and professionals to receive tax payer funded health coverage and pension benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin recognizes that taxpayers should not be funding pensions or health coverage for part-time public employees who are not devoted to full-time public service as a full-time employee; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin has previously adopted Resolution R-238-04 which authorized part-time municipal employees to enroll in the health insurance program maintained for full-time employees by the Township of Franklin on certain conditions including that the part time employee pay 100% of the premium cost for enrollment in said health insurance program plus an additional fee in the amount of \$10.00 per month to the Township of Franklin as an administrative fee to cover the costs associated with processing payments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin does hereby prohibit part-time elected or appointed officials and professionals from receiving tax payer funded health benefits and pensions.
