RESOLUTION CANCELLING SPECIAL EMERGENCY AUTHORIZATION COVID-19

WHEREAS, the Township has previously adopted ordinance providing a special emergency appropriation pursuant to NJSA 40A:4-53(m) to fund certain extraordinary revenue losses incurred directly attributable to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance authorized a special emergency appropriation of \$275,000 in the Current Fund; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with regulations promulgated by the State of NJ Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services, the special emergency appropriations for COVID-19 may not exceed the actual deficit in revenues incurred; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Franklin, that the special emergency authorization balance of \$275,000 in the Current Fund be hereby cancelled as of December 31, 2020.
