ADOPTING THE FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT
RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, has conferred with the Township of Franklin Police Chief for adoption of the Rules and Regulations of the Franklin Township Police Department as contained in the Department of Police, Franklin Township, New Jersey Police Manual; and

WHEREAS, the police manual has been compiled in accordance with the Franklin Township Ordinances and New Jersey State Statutes relating to the Administration of the Franklin Township Police Department, Conditions of Employment and Conduct of its Members; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinances of Franklin Township for the Government, Discipline, Administration and Operation of the Department of Public Safety and its members, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin has determined that this Police Manual shall be adopted for the efficient operation of the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, New Jersey that The Department of Police, Franklin Township, New Jersey Police Manual, dated 2022, shall be adopted as the rules, regulations and standard operating procedures for the efficient operation of the Township of Franklin Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
