**RESOLUTION APPOINTING CONFLICT MUNICIPAL PROSECUTORS FOR
THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT
FOR THE YEAR 2022**

WHEREAS, Joseph DiNicola, Esquire was appointed as the Township’s Municipal Prosecutor via Resolution No. 9-22; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:25-4e permits a municipality to appoint additional Municipal Prosecutors as necessary to administer justice in a timely and effective manner in its Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need for the services of a conflict Municipal Prosecutor in the Township of Franklin Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5, in effect provides that Contracts for Professional Services and Contracts for Services of an Extraordinary Unspecifiable Nature may be negotiated by the governing body of a municipality without public advertising and bidding, but requires a brief notice of the fact and details of each such contract to be publicly advertised and that the contract and authorizing resolution be filed in the Municipal Clerk’s Office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, as follows:

The Township Committee hereby appoints for the year 2022, the following Attorneys At Law as conflict Municipal Prosecutors: John A. Moustakas, Esquire; and Alison B. Weinroth, Esquire; to be paid \$160 per hour.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the contract is awarded without competitive bidding as exceptions in the Local Public Contracts Law, either because said party contracted with is authorized by law to practice a recognized profession in the State of New Jersey or the services to be performed are extraordinary unspecifiable services which cannot be bid competitively because it is impossible to prepare specifications for same in accordance with the above mentioned statutes. The contract is being awarded pursuant to a fair and open process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of said notice as required by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 shall be published in the Township’s official newspaper within ten (10) days after passage of this Resolution.
