

**ORDINANCE  
O-19-22**

**AMENDING CHAPTER 290-10 AND 290-13 FEES FOR TRAFFIC DIRECTORS  
AND OTHER SERVICES RENDERED OTHER THAN TRAFFIC**

**WHEREAS**, The code of the Township of Franklin establishes fees for Traffic Directors and after review of the fees it has been determined that the fees should be adjusted;

**290-10 Payment for services rendered by traffic directors.**

A. Payment for all certified police officers working all construction highway details for directing the appropriate movement of traffic flow may be coordinated by the Chief of Police or designee. The payment shall be the appropriate hourly time and one-half rate (overtime) designated by the Police Department but no less than **\$75.00** per hour or the then prevailing rate paid for police traffic services by the County of Gloucester or the State of New Jersey **with an additional appropriate percentage fees for fringe benefits to include but not limited to Social Security, unemployment insurance, Workman's Comp and a fifteen (15%)-percent administrative fee** added to the subtotal for all of the expenses that are required. The aforementioned Fees shall be waived for nonprofit organizations (Delsea Regional, Township of Franklin, Our Lady of Mercy Academy Schools and such other nonprofit institutions that have permanent locations in the Township of Franklin). **All school events will remain at 55/hr.**

B. in the event the Chief of Police or designee determines that the use of a police motor vehicle is necessary, a fee of **\$35 per hour** or any part thereof for the use of said vehicle will be charged and made payable to the Township of Franklin Chief Financial Officer

C. All calculated payment amounts for road detail assignments shall be invoiced / contracted in advance (may be waived for the abovementioned nonprofit organizations) through an off-duty police escrow account to be known as the "Police Overtime Account" and all funds collected for services rendered shall be paid by and through such account.

**D. Once a detail is scheduled and paid for, any changes or modifications to actual time worked at the discretion of the contractor paying for traffic services shall be approved only by the Township Administrator or his designee. Ex. Contractor requests a six (6) hour detail and pays for same, but detail is completed in four (4) hours. Administrator has the ability to order reimbursement for the unused "officer overtime compensation" and hourly vehicle charge. The administrative fee will not be refundable. There shall be no carry over from contracted assignment to another future contracted assignment. Inclement weather which prohibits the contracted work from occurring, shall be compensated to the Township at a rate equivalent to three (3) hours of calculated rates and fees.**

**§ 290-13 Payment for services rendered other than traffic.** A. Payment for certified police officers working all details other than traffic shall be coordinated by the Chief of Police or his designee. The payment shall be the appropriate hourly time and one-half rate (overtime) designated by the Police Department but no less than **\$75.00** per hour or the then prevailing rate paid for actual police services provided by the Franklin Township Police Department, County of Gloucester in the State of New Jersey **with an additional appropriate percentage fees for fringe benefits to include but are not limited to Social Security, unemployment insurance, Workman's Comp and a Fifteen (15%) percent administrative fee added to the subtotal Township of Franklin, NJ Police Services**, Use of for all of the expenses that are required. The aforementioned fees shall be waived for nonprofit organizations (Delsea Regional High School, Township of Franklin, Our Lady of Mercy Academy schools and other nonprofit institutions that have permanent locations in the Township of Franklin).

B. In the event the Chief of Police or designee determines that the use of a police motor vehicle is necessary, a fee of **\$35** per hour or any part thereof for the use of said vehicle will be charged and made payable to the Township Chief Financial Officer,

C. All calculated payment amounts for assignments shall be invoice / contracted in advance (may be waived for the aforementioned nonprofit organizations) through an off-duty police escrow account to be known as the "Police Overtime Account" and all funds collected for services rendered shall be by and through such account. Reference is made to Township of Franklin Code concerning the "Safe Traffic Control for Construction, Repair and Maintenance of Streets and Highways and Third Party Police Department Overtime."

D. **Once a detail is scheduled and paid for, any changes or modifications to actual time worked at the discretion of the contractor paying for traffic services shall be approved only by the Township Administrator or his designee. Ex. Contractor requests a six (6) hour detail and pays for same, but detail is completed in four (4) hours. Administrator has the ability to order reimbursement for the unused "officer overtime compensation" and hourly vehicle charge. The administrative fee will not be refundable. There shall be no carry over from contracted assignment to another future contracted assignment. Inclement weather which prohibits the contracted work from occurring, shall be compensated to the Township at a rate equivalent to three (3) hours of calculated rates and fees.**

**SECTION 1.** If any section, sentence, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of the competent jurisdiction, such holdings shall not effect or impair any other section, sentence, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, adoption and publication provided by law
