

**RESOLUTION
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
RESOLUTION APPROVING A SIX MONTH TEMPORARY TRAILER PERMIT
WITH CONDITIONS
R-212-13**

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Township of Franklin is in receipt of an undated letter authored by Steven Polillo requesting a six month extension for the temporary trailer permit which was issued in response to the partial destruction of his property as a result of a fire; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Township of Franklin has discretion to extend said permits in accordance with municipal ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin is also aware that there are certain property maintenance issues on Mr. Polillo's property which require correction; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin believes it is in the best interest of the Township to support its resident in allowing an extension of the temporary trailer permit provided that the resident comply with property maintenance codes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the application for a six month extension for the temporary trailer permit in favor of Mr. Polillo be and is hereby approved subject to the following condition:

1. Mr. Polillo shall be responsible, within thirty (30) days, to correct any and all property maintenance issues as have been identified by either the Zoning Officer or the Administrator of the Township of Franklin.
