RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE AMBULANCE**

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Ambulance Corp officers met with the Finance Committee and Acting Administrator to discuss the need for a new ambulance

WHEREAS, the new ambulance will replace an older model ambulance that has high mileage and is over the ten year limit for service as prescribed by the NJ Department of Health and Human Services,

WHEREAS, a new ambulance will reduce the cost of maintenance on the existing ambulance fleet and provide a unit with the latest technology for transporting and saving lives with optimal safety for patient services and the EMT's,

WHEREAS, there is funding in place from an bond ordinance to fund such vehicle,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Franklin Township Governing Body that they authorize the Acting Administrator to prepare bid specs and advertise for bids for a new ambulance,

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Judson Moore, Acting Administrator is authorized the purchase of the ambulance after bids have been received and are in order not to exceed \$200,000.
