RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CONDITIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE  
APPROVAL OF A LIQUOR LICENSE IN FAVOR OF SAM AYDIN**

**WHEREAS**, Sam Aydin appeared before the Township Committee seeking to extend the conditions associated with the sale of a liquor license to said person which conditions required the construction and operation of a retail center within one year from the grant of the license; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has considered requests for extension by Mr. Aydin in the past; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Aydin was represented by Robert Wiltsee, Esquire and Dante Parente, Esquire; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee having considered the request of Mr. Aydin through his attorneys finds that the generalized downturn in the economy which resulted in the Legislature adopting the Permit Extension Act, together with the apparent good faith of Mr. Aydin, provides a basis for extending the condition originally imposed with regard to the sale of the liquor license;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the application by Mr. Aydin for extension of the conditions of the approval of his liquor licenses be and are hereby extended as to all conditions until December 31, 2014.
