FROM THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY APPROVING TOTALLY
DISABLED VETERAN STATUS.
FOR BLOCK 5702 LOT 50.03.**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey is in receipt of a request from the Municipal Tax Collector of the Township of Franklin for a Resolution authorizing a refund to the Quicken Loans an overpayment of 2013 Property Taxes due to a reduction in Tax Assessment due to the Gloucester County Tax Assessor Approving a Totally Disabled Veterans Status.; and

WHEREAS, Robert & Mary F. Johnson are the owners of record of Block 5702, Lot 50.03 on the Tax Map of the Township of Franklin, also known as 2747 Main Road; and

WHEREAS, in the 2013 Tax Year, this property received a Totally Disabled Veterans Status by the Gloucester County Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector of the Township of Franklin is in receipt of a request by Quicken Loans, for a refund of the Overpayment due to the Tax Exempt Status of \$ 1,405.46 to be refunded to the Mortgage Company for Block 5702, Lot 50.03; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and discussion with the Township Administrator, Treasurer, and Tax Collector, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester has determined that it is appropriate for the Township of Franklin to refund the overpayment payment of taxes to Quicken Loans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the Overpayment of real property taxes in the amount of \$ 1,405.46, shall be refunded to Quicken Loans, Servicing – Attn: Tax Team, 635 Woodward Ave., Detroit, MI 48226; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Tax Collector and Treasurer of the Township of Franklin for their records.
