RESOLUTION NO. R-124-24

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN TO APPLY AND ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE NEW JERSEY DIVISION OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS UNDER THE LEAD REMEDIATION AND ABATEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, effective July 22, 2022, the Legislature enacted P.L. 2021, c.182, “As Act concerning certain lead-based paint hazard, and residential rental property, and establishing lead-based paint hazard programs supplementing P.L. 2003, c.311 (C.52:27D-437.1 et.a.); and

WHEREAS, the grant is from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (“DCA”) to provide lead-safe repairs, and support energy efficiency in residential units built prior to 1978 to address the ongoing threat of childhood lead poisoning in Franklin Township, Gloucester County; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Housing Preservation wishes to administer services under the lead hazard control assistance act; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin desires to apply for and obtain a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for approximately \$2,000,000.00 to carry out a project to perform lead remediation; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, Gloucester County, New Jersey, that they acknowledge and approve the parameters of the above NJDCA Grant Application and award parameters, and understands that the actual amount awarded as stated above maybe lesser or greater as determined by the NJDCA. The Township of Franklin will utilize the monies to supplement and implement a rental registration program and lead based paint hazards inspection process for rental properties within the Township.
