**TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN  
RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM THE COULBOURN AND  
ALBERTSON FAMILIES OF THE FRANKLINVILLE RAILROAD STATION  
BUILDING

**WHEREAS**, the Franklinville Railroad Station has been on display in the Township of Franklin at the Franklinville Lake Property on Coles Mill Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coulbourn and Albertson families have since 2007 loaned use of the train station to Franklin Township in the memories of Robert and Dora Albertson; and

**WHEREAS**, now wish to fully donate the Franklinville Railroad Station building to Franklin Township, Gloucester County. This donation shall remain in perpetuity, until such time that Franklin Township deems it no longer can sustain or maintain said property, then the property shall be reverted back to the Coulbourn and/or Albertson family descendants; and

**WHEREAS**, the interior contents and display items inside of the Franklinville Train Station shall remain the property of the Coulbourn and Albertson families, but will remain on loan to Franklin Township, Gloucester County; and

**WHEREAS**, upon the passing of this resolution the care and upkeep of the entire building and grounds shall fall to the care of Franklin Township, Gloucester County immediately upon passage; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the donation of the Franklinville Train Station sought to be made by Coulbourn and Albertson families to Franklin Township be and is hereby ratified and authorized and the Township Solicitor and Clerk are hereby authorized to take whatever steps are necessary in order to effectuate the transfer of actual building to the Township of Franklin.
