AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR UPGRADED BODY-WORN CAMERAS AND CLOUD BASED BACKUP TO COBAN TECHNOLOGIES, INC. / SAFE FLEET LAW ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS, Franklin Township Police Department is in need to new and upgraded supply body worn cameras and a backup retention system for the Police Department; the State of New Jersey Division of Property has authorized vendors that can provide these services, materials, supplies or equipment under a “State Contract” for eligible items pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12; and

WHEREAS, Coban Technologies, Inc. / Safe Fleet Law Enforcement, with a mailing address of 9411 S. Sam Houston Parkway West – Ste 300, Houston, Texas 77489, has submitted proposal Q-63481 dated July 25, 2024, through NJ State Contract 17-FLEET-00731 for a five (5) year program in the amount of \$285,285.00, to supply Body-Worn Cameras and a cloud based backup system to the Franklin Township Police Department as described in Exhibit A, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief of the Township of Franklin and the Township Committee have reviewed the proposal; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Township of Franklin to enter into a Contract with Coban Technologies, Inc. / Safe Fleet Law Enforcement under the terms and conditions in the July 25, 2024, proposal with a yearly cost not to exceed \$65,621.00 in 2025 and \$52,416.00 in years 2026 through 2029; and

WHEREAS, the CFO has certified the availability of funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 for the 2024 deposit from two (2) separate forfeiture funds accounts T-26-56-850-801 (\$2,000) and T-26-56-850-805 (\$8,000). Funds shall be appropriated in future year budgets as follows, Year 2025 shall be charged to the Police Equipment Maintenance 5-01-25-240-205, in the amount not to exceed \$65,621.00. Years 2026 through 2029 shall be charged to the Police Equipment Maintenance (**2026** – 6-01-25-240-205; **2027** – 6-01-25-240-205; **2028** – 6-01-25-240-205; **2029** – 6-01-25-240-205; total amount not to exceed in all years is \$285,285.00

NOW, THREERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Coban Technologies, Inc. / Safe Fleet Law Enforcement’s July 25, 2024, proposal for new Body-Worn Cameras and cloud back-up system to the Franklin Township Police Department is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of Police and Administrator of the Township of Franklin, Gloucester County, New Jersey, are hereby authorized and directed to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the July 25, 2024, proposal.
