WHEREAS, the Township desires to replace the Administrative and Police Department illuminated sign which borders Delsea Drive;

WHEREAS, Effective Sign Works, 1624 Jacksonville Road, Burlington, NJ 08016 has a NJ state recognized Sourcewell purchasing co-op, via a public bidding process for the same with a co-op member number of #030223-WCH;

WHEREAS, Effective Sign Works has a sign cabinet, 2 new 8mm full color digital message boards and steel upright pole available for purchase under above Sourcewell co-op in the amount of \$56,948.41 for the sign and cabinet as stated under quote #:240261-04;

WHEREAS, the CFO has certified the availability of funds from Grant budget line-item No. G-02-41-717-003, entitled National Opioids Settlement Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey as follows; the CFO is authorized to complete the financial transactions associated with purchasing the above identified double sided illuminated sign for the Franklin Township Administration and Police Department, in the amount of \$56,948.41 for the sign, warranty, cloud based software and wireless broadband data charges..
