

**TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING A PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR THE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE YEAR 2016,
PURSUANT TO LOCAL PUBLIC CONTRACTS LAW
(N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, ET SEQ.)**

WHEREAS, there exists a need for a Public Defender in the Township of Franklin for the Franklin Township Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, the Township Committee has determined to award said contract as a fair and open contract; and

WHEREAS, funds are or will be available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires the governing body of a contracting unit to publish a notice in a newspaper authorized by law to publish its legal advertisements, setting forth the nature, duration, service and amount of the contract where such contract is awarded for "professional services" without competitive bidding.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That MARK KARGMAN is hereby retained as Public Defender for the Township of Franklin for the year 2016.

2. The appropriate officers of the Township of Franklin are hereby authorized to enter into the contract with MARK KARGMAN of 6215 Black Horse Pike, Egg Harbor Township, NJ 08234 for the legal services above specified, for a one (1) year term commencing January 1, 2016, and to be paid in accordance with the Salary Ordinance.

3. The contract is awarded as a "professional service" under the provision of the Local Public Contracts Law because the specialized training, education, experience and specialized knowledge needed for this position and pursuant to a "fair and open" process as provided in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

4. A notice of the award of this contract shall forthwith be printed once in The Sentinel of Gloucester County, an official newspaper of the Township of Franklin, authorized by law to publish the legal advertisements of the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, setting forth the nature, duration, service and amount of the contract, and further stating that this resolution and the annexed contract are on file and available for public inspection in the Office of the Clerk of the Township of Franklin.

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN AND MARK D. KARGMAN**

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin, hereinafter referred to as "Township", requires the services of a Public Defender for the calendar year 2016, commencing January 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, MARK KARGMAN, of 6215 Black Horse Pike, Egg Harbor Township, NJ 08215, hereinafter referred to as "Township Public Defender", is a licensed attorney in the State of New Jersey, has agreed to accept the appointment of the Township for the performance of the duties of attorney subject to the following terms and conditions:

WITNESSETH:

1. The Township Public Defender shall be appointed to a one (1) year term to represent the Township for the calendar year 2016 commencing January 1, 2016, and he shall perform all duties required of a local representative of the Township Municipal Court.

2. During the term of this Agreement, the Township Public Defender shall devote his best efforts to advance the interest of the Township; he shall perform his duties to the best of his ability and in accordance with the Code of Professional Ethics by the New Jersey Supreme Court.

3. The Township Public Defender shall receive a salary as set forth in the Salary Ordinance of the Township of Franklin.
