**RESOLUTION GRANTING TAX EXEMPTION FOR A
TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN**

WHEREAS, James W. Killingsworth, who resides at and is the owner of certain real estate in the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey known as Block 103, Lot 35 located at 2851 Williamstown Road, Franklinville was deemed a 100%, totally and permanently disabled veteran in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A 54:4-3.30; and

WHEREAS, James W. Killingsworth, made the appropriate claim for tax exemption thru the Gloucester County Assessor's Office as a 100%, totally and permanently disabled veteran and was approved by their office effective May 2, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the property known as 2851 Williamstown Road, Block 103, Lot 35, Franklinville, New Jersey is hereby designated as a tax exempt property as the property owner, James W. Killingsworth, is a 100%, totally and permanently disabled veteran and therefore all property taxes on said property from May 2, 2016 forward are hereby cancelled.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a properly executed copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Tax Collector and Treasurer for the records.
