**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN TAX
COLLECTOR TO PREPARE AND MAIL ESTIMATED TAX BILLS IN
ACCORDANCE WITH P.L. 1994, C. 72**

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin has not adopted the 2016 Municipal Budget, the County of Gloucester Board of Taxation is unable to certify the Township of Franklin tax rate at this time and the Township of Franklin Tax Collector will not be able to mail the Township's 2016 tax bills on a timely basis; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 72, P.L. 1994, the Township of Franklin Committee will not need approval from the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to issue the estimated tax bills since the estimated tax levy does not exceed the 105% maximum allowed; and

WHEREAS, approval for the resolution will enable the Township of Franklin to meet its financial obligations, assist in maintaining the tax collection rate and provide for uniform tax payments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey on the June 14, 2016, as follows:

1. The Township of Franklin Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Township for the third installment of 2016 taxes. The Tax Collector shall proceed upon approval from the Director and take such actions as are permitted and required by L. 1994, c. 72 (N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2 AND 54:4-66.3).
2. The entire estimated tax levy for 2016 is hereby set at \$ \$ 39,308,300.79.
3. The 2016 fire district tax levies are set as, No.1 at \$470,554.00, No. 2 at \$404,369.00, No. 3 at \$271,981.00, No. 4 at \$500,401.00 and No. 5 at \$239,160.00.
4. In accordance with law, the third installment of 2016 taxes shall not be subject to interest until the later of August 10th or the twenty-fifth calendar day after the date the estimated tax bills were mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date on which interest may begin to accrue.
